COVID circumstances made this inevitable
2	To approve the minutes for the AGM 2019	Minutes approved unanimously
3	To receive the Trustees' Report and Financial Statement for year ending March 31 2020	The Chair invited the meeting to receive the Trustees' report and Financial statement for year ending March 31 <sup>st</sup> , 2020 <b>Trustees' report and financial statement approved unanimously</b> MB commented that although fund raising and income from the bus was severely reduced a grant cheque for £4,900 had been received this morning, so the financial position of the bus was now relatively unaffected by the COVID restrictions.

The meeting voted unanimously to reappoint them for a further term of three years.

8	To confirm the appointment as chair of Henry Edwards	Henry Edwards elected unanimously as Chair
9	To review and endorse the progress report for 2019-20 and action plan 2020-21	Report endorsed unanimously following a video presentation (instead of the usual report by the group leaders)
10	To reduce the quorum for the AGM to 5% of the total membership	Subject to approval by the Charities Commission this was approved by 21 votes to 2 (new Chair to check with Charities Commission)
11	Proposed amendment to the Partnerships' Objects regarding support for residents experiencing hardship and responses to community emergency or crisis	The meeting was asked to approve the addition of the following sub-clause to the end of Clause 3 of the Memorandum of Association:  "(6) Providing food, goods and/or services which some residents could not otherwise afford, and responding in an appropriate manner to any community emergency or extraordinary crisis or situation."  Subject to approval by Charity Commission this was approved unanimously (new Chair to check with Charities Commission)
